Before your lawn goes dormant for the winter, there are seven crucial steps that you must take to ensure that you have a beautiful lawn next year.



1. **Rake the leaves off of the lawn.** Leaves will block light and trap moisture, which could smother your grass underneath.
2. **Keep mowing your grass.** Grass continues to grow until the first hard frost. The ideal height is 2 1/2" to 3".
3. **Continue to water the grass** through October, if there is less than 1" of rain per week.
4. **Aerate the soil** every couple of years, right before fertilizing. This allows the soil to be ready to receive air, water, nutrients.
5. **Fertilize** with a late fall application of slow release granular 24-0-10 nitrogen, phosphorus, and potassium.
6. **Spread grass seed** to protect against weeds, and make sure that the seed is in direct contact with the soil.
7. **Stick to the recommended schedule.** Each step has to be done at the recommended time, or it is a waste of effort.
